SCARF NECKLACE I ALPACA SOFTY

DESIGNED TO BE WORN WITH A PIN FROM ROMI

MATERIALS:

Frog Tree 100% Alpaca - chunky weight:
one (1) 50 gram skein (54 yards), color 31 (periwinkle blue)
US 9 knitting needles
US "H" crochet hook
Pin by Romi to close neck

MEASUREMENTS:

Finished measurements as in photo: 4 inches x 17.5 inches
Gauge as in photo: 5 stitches per inch
note: yarn is knitted tighter than specified on ball band for
extra body and durability

ABBREVIATIONS:

yo: yarn over needle

STITCHES USED:

Twisted stockinette stitch, worked by knitting into the back of each knit stitch and purling into the back of each purl stitch

Row 1: knit into the back leg of each stitch

Row 2: purl into the back leg of each stitch

Single crochet

DIRECTIONS:

Cast on 18 stitches loosely, using your preferred method.

Work two rows of twisted stockinette stitch.

Begin short rows using Japanese short row method:

work (knit side facing) 11 stitches (there will be 7 stitches left on the left needle), turn work, yo right needle (forms extra stitch) and purl (still twisted) back 4 stitches (there are 7 stitches remaining on the left needle), turn work, yarn over right needle and knit (still twisted) back until coming to the yo. Knit the yo together with the next stitch - DO NOT twist this stitch - and then knit the next stitch twisted. There are now five stitches remaining on the left needle. Turn work and yo, purling (twisted) back to the yo. Purl the yo together with the next stitch, twisting this stitch. Purl one more stitch and then turn work, yo right needle. Continue in the same manner, working two more stitches on each the next four rows inclusive, and then one more stitch on each of the last two rows.

Work straight in twisted stockinette stitch until you have reached the desired length minus two inches, ending after completing a purl row.

Work short row section as above between *s.

Work two rows twisted stockinette stitch.

Bind off loosely and DO NOT cut yarn. Insert crochet hook through last loop and single crochet 5 stitches into the corner stitch. Continue in single crochet along edge, picking up the whole outside stitch (two strands of yarn) and skipping every other stitch. You will be picking up one stitch for every two knit rows. Crochet 5 stitches in the corner stitch and then pick up a loop to crochet in each and every stitch on the end of the scarf. Crochet 5 stitches in the corner stitch and continue along long side crocheting as for opposite side. Crochet 5 stitches in the corner and then crochet across the end as for opposite side. Tie off yarn and cut, leaving enough end to weave in. Weave in ends and block.
